Packed artistic constellation revolves around music

Gravitating around its iconic music stages, Paléo Festival Nyon will also offer an alternative, multi-disciplinary artistic programme from 23 to 28 July. Dedicated to the circus and street arts, this year La Ruche will take a mischievous look in the rear-view mirror to evoke transmission between generations, while the Village du Monde will showcase Balkan music and will feature a host of events and food stalls. To add to this packed artistic constellation, the Face Nord stage, at the heart of HES-SO's *Paradoxe* project, will host a series of student musical projects, stands, and a host of activities around the theme of "paradox".

Intergenerational transmission at La Ruche

For its 15th year, La Ruche will celebrate the theme of transmission. Throughout the Festival, a dozen circus and street arts companies will buzz about the beloved, secret garden of La Ruche. A touching tribute to the generations who have populated this unusual place over the years, this anniversary is the perfect opportunity to take a look in the rear-view mirror while stepping into the future.

The Village du Monde sets course for the Balkans

For its 20th year, the village will focus on the Balkans, a rich multicultural region in Europe, with an immersive programme featuring some twenty concerts, intimate shows, random tours, and a selection of food stalls. The scenography will honour the symbolism of the bridge, an architectural work characteristic of the region, through an impressive structure that will be the setting for a stage and a bar. As part of its charity partnerships, Paléo will team up this year with the Bosnian institution Mostar Rock School, which will be performing on Scène du Pont with the band Liron, made up of students.
